

# Tiki vs Alfresco

---

## Similar

- Both are enterprise content management systems.

## Different

- Alfresco's roots are in document management (files), whilst Tiki's roots is in web (wiki, blog, etc)
- Tiki is [community open source](#) while Alfresco is [single-vendor commercial open source](#). Thus, Alfresco has a "community" version and an "enterprise" version.
- Alfresco is written in Java whereas Tiki is written in PHP.
- Tiki hosting requirements are easier ([shared hosting](#))
- Tiki has a [File Gallery](#) while [wiki.alfresco.com](#) uses MediaWiki
